

The CBC Broadcast
about Immortal Performances wins the
WORLD GOLD MEDAL
for
BEST DOCUMENTARY (Classical)
at the
INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL OF RADIO AND TELEVISION
New York 2000

The CBC broadcast a three-quarter hour documentary about IPRMS (an interview between CBC's Michael Juk and Richard Caneill, archivist and Sound Engineer for the Music Society) on *In Performance*, Friday, 19th January 1999 and again the following week and yet again the following September.

Thereafter the CBC submitted the program to the International Radio Awards Jury at the New York Festivals, June 2000, at which it was awarded the World Gold Medal.

Since the time of the award the CBC rebroadcast the program three times in the summer and autumn of 2000. The original medal (plaque) is held in the office of the President of the CBC.
