Also Four Last Songs, Strauss' ultimate work: Schwarzkopf / Barbirolli. An important performance heard in good sound. (2 CDs)



MAHLER RARITIES DAS LIED VON DER ERDE, Merriman, Wunderlich GESELLEN LIEDER conducted by Fritz Busch (Premiere on disc) SYMPHONY NO. 2 Stader, Merriman / Kubelik Schlusnus Lieder. Of special interest is the 1939 Das Lied (Holland) heard without the interruption which has long flawed every release.



Good off-the-air sound. The bonus offers Kipnis in Brahms and Schubert Lieder. (2 CDs)



AIDA Met 1941 Roman - Martinelli Castagna - Warren Our restoration returns an important broadcast to circulation. There is much singing here to revere, especially Roman who surprises with the dramatic velocity and the exquisite shape she gives many passages. All the soloists are worth hearing. Good sound, photos, broadcast commentary and a Martinelli interview as a bonus. (3 CDs)



FRANCESCO MERLI TRIBUTE Two operas in which Merli appears with important vocal artists of his era. Newly restored PAGLIÁCCI (1930) with Pampanini and Galeffi. MANOŃ LESCAUT (1931) with Zamboni who sang Liu in the world premiere of Turandot. These La Scala productions were among the most prized of the time. Plus Merli duets (78rpm). (3 CDs)
